
BOARD APPROVES SOUND SYSTEM FUND

At the meeting of the Board last week they heard the report of Building and Grounds Chairman, George

Goodnight, concerning the sound system.

Most of the people in the congregation know that the system is inadequate and in need of repair.

George said that after research and inspection by a Sound System Company that has refurbished, repaired or replaced several systems, an estimate was asked for and received. The estimated cost is \$3,500. He said that the estimate was received last year and at that time it was felt the church could not afford it.

George said that the Building and Grounds Committee now feels it needs to be put on the front burner.

Already, members have contributed \$1,500. This is about

30% of our goal. The committee will not let the contract until the \$3,500 is in hand.

Additional pledges of approximately \$1,500 have already been received from members.
