The second guest in our “Hands On Mission” programs will be Daniel Gourdet, who is our Tennessee Global Mission Partner. Gourdet was born in Aguin, Haiti. He has served with Global Ministries of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) for 25 years. His ministries have included the Democratic Republic of the Congo (formerly Zaire) as a government teacher and principal of the high school. He served in Swaziland in the School Development program and in Zimbabwe in administration development.

Since 2003 Gourdet has served in his native Haiti as a consultant for development programs. He is

married to Sandra Rucker Gourdet. He is a member of Macedonia Christian Church in Birmingham, Alabama. The Gourdets are parents of Nicolas Patrice and Helene Danielle.

Haiti is the poorest nation in the Western World. The Roman Catholic Church is the largest church and there is a sizable group who practice Voodoo. But we Disciples have an extensive ministry there through CONASPEH, the National Spiritual Council

of Haitian Churches. Our Regional Minister, Dr. Glen Steward leads an annual mission tour of Haiti, which Bill Pennington and our minister have participated.
